SACLANT's and CINCHAN's requests to NATO countries

Only 8 countries are concerned by SACLANT's requests.
They are: Canada, Denmark, France, Netherlands, Portugal, Norway, United Kingdom, United States.

Only 4 countries are concerned by CINCHAN's requests.
They are: Belgium, France, Netherlands, United Kingdom.

- a) The first requests by SACLANT AND CINCHAN have been circulated to the delegations on September 6th (PO/61/722). Additional requests and supplementary requirements have been circulated on September 15th (PO/61/730).
- b) The delay which could be allowed to the countries to send their replies should normally be about as long as the one allowed for the answers by countries to SACEUR's requests. Those were delivered on August 21st and answers were requested for September 4th. I would therefore suggest, because a clear-cut distinction cannot be maintained between the first set of requests by SACLANT and CINCHAN and the second, that all countries should be asked for answers to be delivered to the International Secretariat by the 25th September.
