It is possible that the German Defence Minister may raise at some point in the Ministerial Meeting the importance he attached to the problem of refugees.

2. In this connection, I notice that, under Appendix A of SGM-593-62(Revised)* in which the selected reinforced alert measures required to be implemented during Phase II are set out, the measure R.A.P. is included. This measure requires preparations for the evacuation of inhabitants of certain operational areas.

3. If the German Defence Minister does raise the question of refugees, it would, I think, be very useful if the Acting Secretary General were in a position to enlarge on the magnitude of this operation in connection with BERCON Planning. It would also be helpful if he knew the extent to which the NATO military commands concerned have pre-planned this evacuation with the Federal or other Land governments concerned.
