MEMORANDUM FOR THE SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER EUROPE

SUBJECT: ACE Responses to an Intervention in Poland

References: A. SACEUR Letter (O/CMC/50/81, 1 July 1981)
B. MCM-EKD-41-81, 7 July 1981

1. Your letter (Reference A) outlining the measures you wished the Military Committee and the DPC to consider was discussed at the MC meetings of 2 July and 6 July. The decision taken was that Reference A., together with MC advice (Reference B.) be forwarded to the Secretary General as soon as possible.
2. The Secretary General received the documents early on 7 July, and the subject was discussed by Ambassadors later that same day. I understand that Ambassadors were in general agreement that the measures you proposed should be considered in capitals, and noted that, indeed, this process was already underway as a consequence of Military Committee discussions.
3. It does not appear likely, at this point, that References A. and B. will be formally considered by the DPC.
