

- Turkey, Greece, Romania, Bulgaria, Georgia, Russia and the USA participated. Most likely threat scenarios were discussed. Efforts/applications on the security of narrow waterways are presented.

Specific Tasks for the Next 6 Months

- High speed boat ramming tanker in narrow waterways
- Locks and dams on navigable waters placed under attack
- Civil aviation aircraft crashes on tankers at dock
- Collusion of crew with hostile groups to enter sensitive port areas
- Underwater explosives/mines,...
