1. Please find below a revision to document OPS(EADRCC)(2023)0021, based on an update request for international assistance from Ukraine.

2. Description

2.1 As a result of the destruction of the dam of the Kakhovka hydroelectric power plant (KHPP), and in accordance with the procedures at reference, the EADRCC has received on 11 June 2023, an update urgent request for international humanitarian assistance by Ukraine to protect its population against the flooding's and it's secondary impact.
