Request

The Mission of Ukraine to NATO has submitted the following request for international assistance via NATO to cope with the urgent needs of the Sumy Region of Ukraine, as identified by the Sumy Regional Military Administration. The request concerns the provision of cogeneration units and water treatment systems – including iron-removal systems – required to ensure the continued functioning of electricity, heat and water supply services for the civilian population.

In line with its obligations, the Euro-Atlantic Disaster Response Coordination Centre (EADRCC) is sharing this request with the Points of Contact for International Disaster Response in NATO Allies and partner countries. Nations in a position to respond to this request, in full or in part, are invited to reply to the Operational Point of Contact listed below, with copy to the EADRCC.

The EADRCC is the point of contact at NATO for all follow-up related to this request. It can help coordinate offers and the delivery of assistance.

General Situation

Russia continues large-scale combined attacks, including those aimed at critical infrastructure.

The requested equipment is intended for civilian use by the relevant regional and municipal authorities, and public utility operators of the Sumy Region of Ukraine, which is close to the border with Russia.

In regard to the ongoing threat posed by attacks against civilian energy, water supply and wastewater infrastructure in the Sumy Region, the Government of Ukraine would be grateful if Allied and partner countries could provide their assistance according to this request, in full or in part.

Description of assistance required:

Need for cogeneration units — 18 units / 35.62 MW (in total):

City of Sumy: 1.2 MW — 2 units,
1.56 MW — 2 units.

City of Trostyanets: 1.5 MW — 1 unit,
1.0 MW — 1 unit.

City of Romny: 2.3 MW — 12 units.

Need for water purification systems (iron removal stations) — 8 units (in total):

City of Sumy — 1 unit;
 City of Konotop — 1 unit;
 City of Lebedyn — 1 unit;
 City of Okhtyrka — 1 unit;
 City of Romny — 1 unit;
 City of Bilopillia — 1 unit;
 City of Buryu — 1 unit;
 City of Trostyanets — 1 unit.
