NATO SECURITY INVESTMENT PROGRAMME FINANCIAL ACTIVITY

AS AT 31 DECEMBER 2024

The NATO Security Investment Programme (NSIP) is an important pillar of NATO common funding. Common funding arrangements apply to the NATO civil and military budgets, and the NSIP. Together, these common-funded budgets reinforce the Alliance, providing major capabilities, enabling deterrence, defence and interoperability, and supporting consultation and decision-making at the highest levels. Allied common funding contributions to NATO are established using an agreed cost-sharing formula derived from the Gross National Income of NATO member countries.

The NSIP supports and contributes to deterrence, defence and security. It funds major construction and command and control systems under the 'over and above' principle, i.e. it is focused on the provision of requirements that would not be reasonable for an Ally to bear individually. It provides installations and facilities such as air defence communication and information systems, military headquarters for the integrated command structure and for deployed operations, as well as critical airfield, fuel systems and maritime infrastructure.

The NSIP is financed by the ministries of defence of each NATO member. Its implementation is overseen by the Investment Committee. Capabilities are delivered either by individual host nations or user nations, by NATO agencies or Strategic Commands. The 2024 ceiling for the NSIP was EUR 1.324.4 million.

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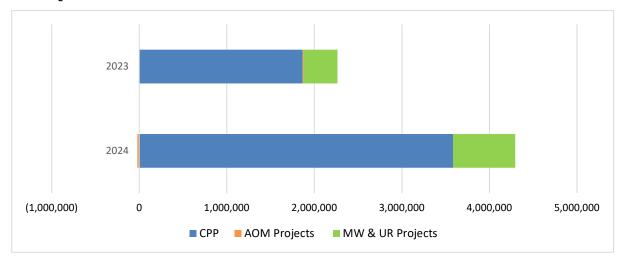

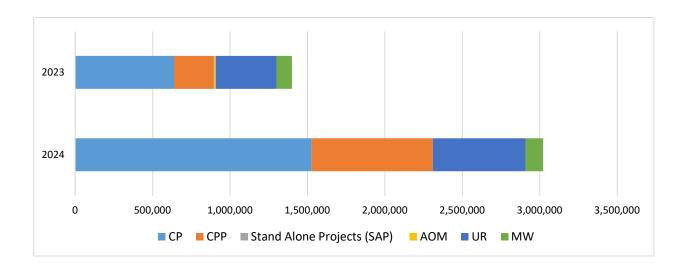

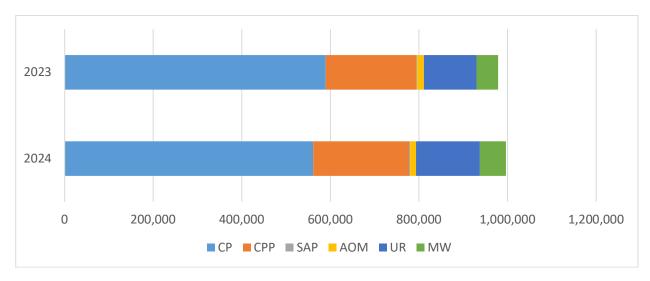

| Audit b | The International Board of Auditors for NATO (IBAN) is mandated to audit the NSIP on behalf of the Council. IBAN's mandate regarding NSIP audits covers NATO Nations as well as NATO entities receiving common funding from NSIP. |
| Authorised Scope k | The Investment Committee authorises Host Nation to implement specific works ("what"), known as the physical scope, and the related funds ("how much"), known as the financial scope. |

It is known as the tool used by the resource community to provide a capability needed by the Strategic Commands to fulfil a military requirement. Capability Package has been superseded by Capability Programme Plan (CPP). |
| | A Capability Programme Plan is a combination of Doctrine, Organisation, Training, |
| Programme Plan | Materiel, Leadership, Personnel, Facilities and Interoperability (DOTMLPFI) components that, when delivered as intended, will enable the Strategic Commands to fulfil a specific military function or requirement. |
| Capabilities | Provides a taxonomy to enable the planning, programming, implementation, operation and ife-cycle management in a transparent and coherent manner, supporting more efficient and effective capability delivery; it does not represent a prioritisation nor a hierarchy. |

| Forecasts | Amount forecasted by Host Nations to be expended during the life time of an NSIP funded project. Forecasts of expenditure are provided per quarters/years in the NSIP database (CIRIS). |
| Host Nation (HN) | Implementing entity, normally an Ally, a NATO Agency or a Strategic Command. Host Nation is responsible and accountable to implement the project within agreed cost, scope and schedule. |
| Investment Committee (IC) | The Investment Committee is one of the NATO Resource Committees. It is responsible for the NSIP implementation. It has delegated authority for Alliance Operations & Missions, Minor Works and Urgent Requirements. |
| Latest Cost Estimate (LCE) | The Latest Cost Estimate is the sum of the amount already expended plus the future expenses forecasted by the HN. The LCE represents the total estimated cost needed to bring the NSIP project to completion. |
| Latest Cost Estimate Remaining to be Spent (LCE RTBS) | The amount of unspent LCE, i.e. Latest Cost Estimate minus Expenditures |
| Medium Term Resource Plan (MTRP) | The Medium-Term Resource Plan is a document used for short to medium-term resource planning. It provides a comprehensive overview of and forward look on activities requiring Common Funding. The MTRP makes recommendations on the resources to be allocated to the Military Budget and the NSIP. |
| Common Funding Resource Plan (CFRP) | The Common Funding Resource Plan (CFRP) consolidates the MTRP and Medium Term Financial Plan into a single overarching and comprehensive plan for the next five years for Council's consideration. |
| Minor Work (MW) | A Minor Work is defined as discrete project, straightforward, self-standing and completely usable, not part of a currently proposed project and not the planning or a consulting aspect associated with a larger project. Minor Works must be in line with the current guidelines for CF. Ceiling, per MW, is currently set at EUR 3,000,000 |
| Prefinancing | Prefinancing is a procedure by which a HN declares to NATO its intention to fund from national resources a project which may later qualify for NSIP funding. |
| Requirement Area | Grouping of NATO strategic objectives. Replaced by CFCF. |
| Stand Alone Project (SAP) | A SAP is a project that is not part of a larger capability. |
| Urgent Requirement (UR) | Urgent requirements are military requirements, in line with the guidelines for common funding, that for reasons of urgency, based on operational, safety, economic or environmental considerations, cannot await approval as part of a CPP and need to be implemented promptly to ensure current necessary operational capability. |
