



Ahmet Avundukluoglu was born in Ankara, Türkiye, in 1982.

He graduated from Ankara University, Faculty of Political Sciences, Department of Public Finance, in 2005. He completed his Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree at the University of Turkish Aeronautical Association in 2015.

He began his professional career at the Turkish Court of Accounts as an Assistant Auditor in 2008. He became a Senior Auditor in 2014 and a Principal Auditor in 2019.

He was appointed as Chief Rapporteur at the 5th Judicial Chamber of the Turkish Court of Accounts in 2020, Advisor to the President in 2022, and Director General in 2023.

While serving as Head of the International Relations Department, he was appointed as a Member of the NATO International Board of Auditors in June 2026, a role he has been serving in since 1 September 2026.
