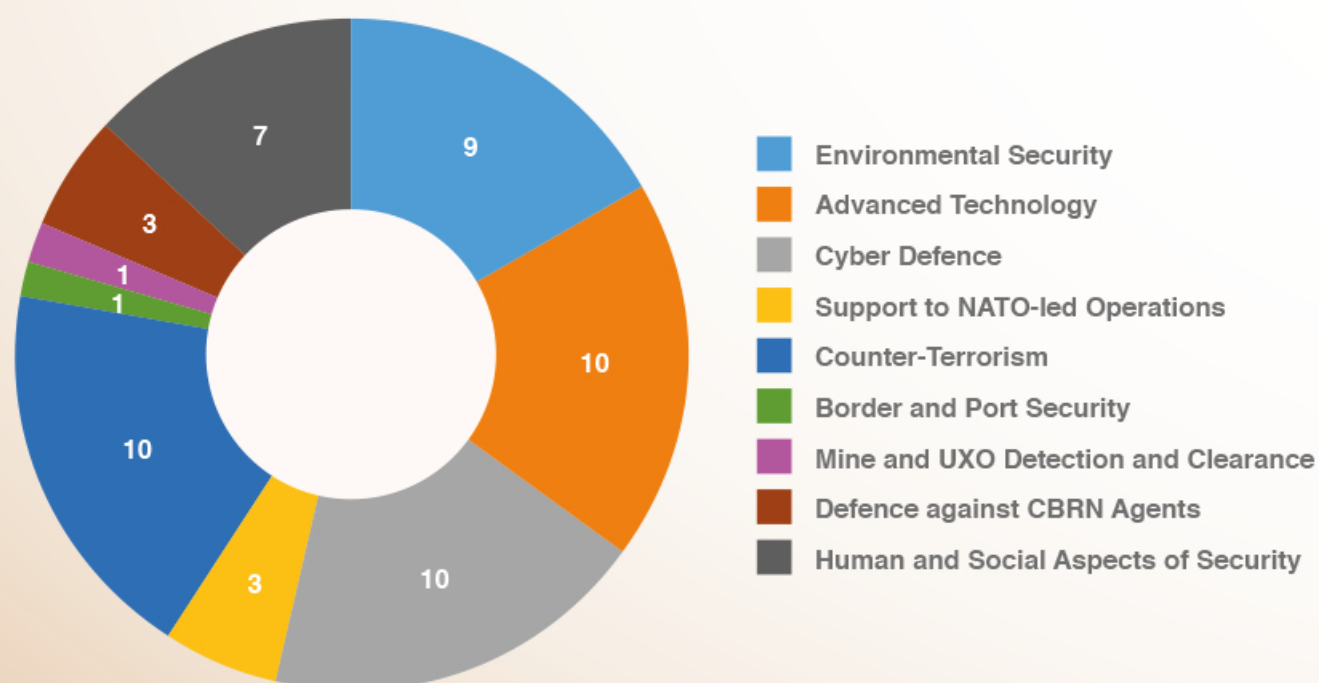
24 NATO and partner countries have cooperated with North Macedonia through SPS activities



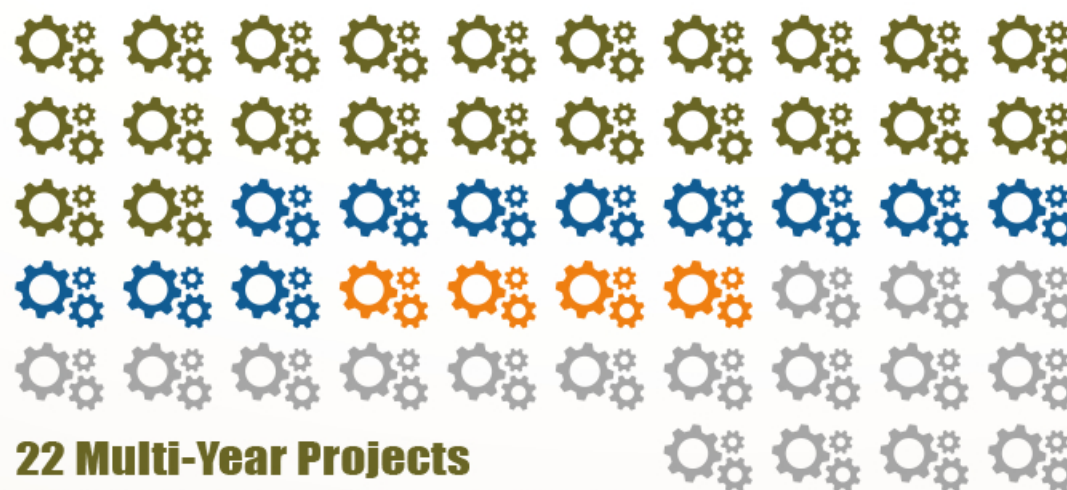
46 young scientists have benefitted from exchanges facilitated by the SPS Programme

SPS activities with North Macedonia by Key Priority



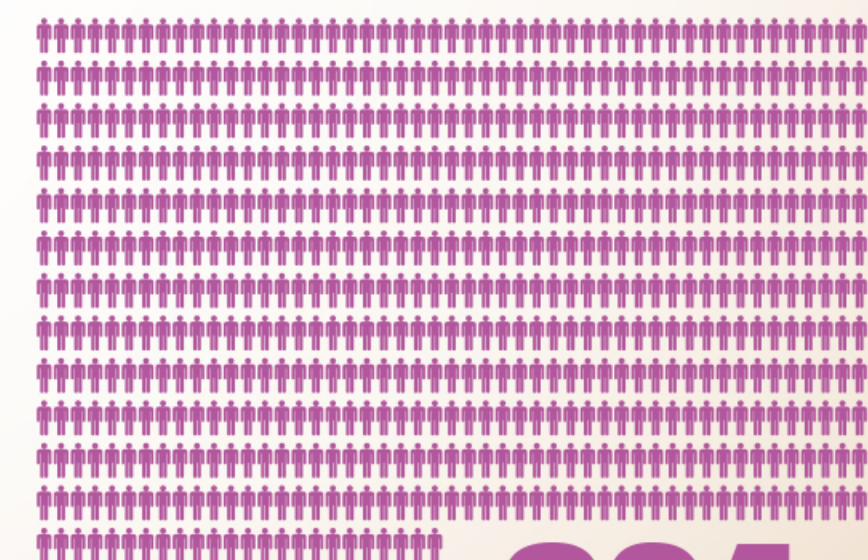
54 activities with scientists and experts from North Macedonia
