Constanze Stelzenmüller (born Bonn, 1962) studied law in Bonn and Geneva (1979-85), with a focus on constitutional, European and international law. German McCloy Scholar at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government (MPA '88), then Visiting Researcher at Harvard Law School ('88-'89). Doctoral thesis on direct democracy in the United States (published by Nomos, 1994). Intern at the Berlin daily *Der Tagesspiegel*, 1992-93. Based at the weekly *Die Zeit* in Hamburg since 1994; international security and defence editor since 1998. Will assume the post of Director of the German Marshall Fund of the United States' Berlin office on July 1.
