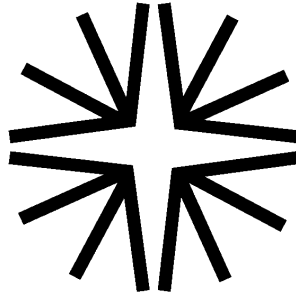

1. Situation

1.1. With the report at reference, the EADRCC promulgated to National Points of Contact for International Disaster Assistance an initial request for assistance related to a possible emergency situation in Turkey.

2. Population movement towards Turkey

2.1. Reports received as of today, do not indicate significant changes in the number of Internally Displaced Persons in Northern Iraq.

2.2. The build up of UNHCR relief stocks in Turkey also continues, and according to reports received the UNHCR has in its regional warehouse in the port city of Iskenderun, in southern Turkey substantial stocks. As of today, the warehouse contains 10.800 tents (sufficient for up to 54.000 people); 95.500 blankets (for around 48.000 people); 58.000 mattresses (for up to 96.000 people); 20.800 stoves; as well as substantial stocks of plastic sheeting, lanterns and jerry cans. A consignment of 360.000 sanitary napkins is being transferred inland to another UNHCR warehouse in Gaziantep. Some additional stocks, including 1.000 tents, 15.000 blankets, 1.000 mattresses and 2.000 stoves, are currently being transferred from the Iskenderun warehouse to bolster the UNHCR stocks in Syria. The warehouse is serving the needs of both Syria and Iraq.

3. Assistance provided to Turkey

3.1. As of today, Bulgaria, Canada, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Hungary, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, the Slovak Republic and Switzerland have informed the EADRCC of offers of assistance to Turkey. Details of these offers to Turkey are provided



in Annex 1 to this report. Annex 2 to the report provides an overview of the outstanding requirements of Turkey.

3.2. In addition, Spain will provide to Turkey humanitarian assistance, details of this assistance will be provided later. This humanitarian assistance will be airlifted to Turkey with an Antonov 124 on 6 April 2003. The remaining lift capacity will be utilised to transport the Croatian consignment to Turkey.

4. **Transportation Request**

4.1. Slovak Republic has requested transportation assistance for their offer of assistance to Turkey. The total volume of the load is approximately 80 cubic metres while the total weight is 16 tons. The cargo does not need special handling.

4.2. EAPC Nations in a position to assist Slovak Republic in the transportation of the cargo are therefore requested to examine whether they might be in a position to provide **the needed transportation** and contact the EADRCC at NATO HQ.
