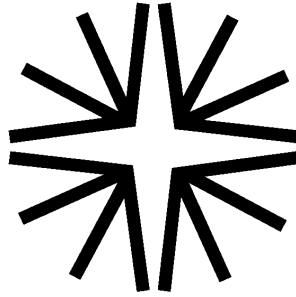

1. The Bulgarian authorities provided the EADRCC with the following updated information on the situation:

The situation in the disaster stricken sites and the Sofia Region remains serious. The most complicated situation presents itself along the river valleys of Iskar. Residential buildings in and around the cities of Sofia, Mezdra, Iskar, Pernik, Svoge, Kyustendil, Pleven are flooded. However, a tendency for a slow drop of water levels of both rivers has been observed.

The Iskar Dam near Sofia city is totally filled to its maximum capacity. It is likely that controlled discharge of the Iskar Dam will be unavoidable. As a result, the water level of Iskar river will again increase downstream of Sofia city. This will require building of additional dams. In some regions landslides occurred and rock and soil masses have blocked up roads.

Today and tomorrow showers are expected. The weather conditions are cool for the season with temperatures from 10 to 18 degrees.

The following assistance left Sweden by truck on Saturday 11. June 2005

- 500 pcs. family tents
- 35 pcs. rubber boats
- 50.000 pcs. sand bags
