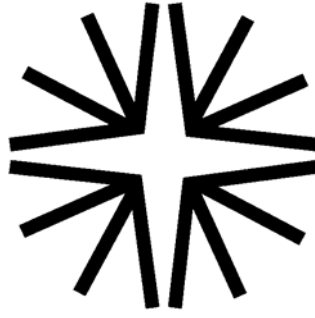

1. The EADRCC received the following information from the Emergency Situations and Civil Safety Service, MIA of Georgia 20.06.2005.

The situation in the Mckheta-Mtianeti region is still very serious. The weather forecast for the next days is heavy rain and the water level is expected to rise. The rescue of the population is intensively ongoing.

The affected population in Daba Dusheti needs immediate support of food and daily subsistence items. However, the local resources in the regions and MIA warehouse are exhausted. The need for international assistance is still urgent.

2. The following requirements for assistance are still outstanding:
