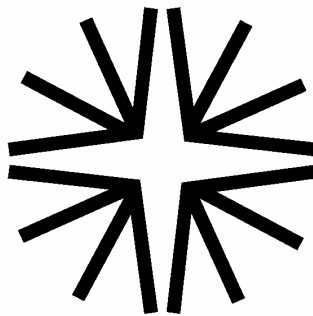

1. Even though floods are receding the situation in the flood stricken counties is still critical as people are still unable to return to their homes.

1.1 The death toll has risen to 30 people, more than 13.000 people have been evacuated. The number of affected localities has risen to 700. The figure for affected agricultural areas has also been revised upwards, from 88.000 ha to 94.000 ha.

1.2 Romanian authorities continue to provide food, water and shelter to the evacuated population. Vaccinations against hepatitis type A and against typhoid are being administered. Efforts to drain flood waters, to remove animal corpses and to distribute pest control substances against insects are ongoing.

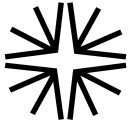

4.1.6 Austrian authorities are investigating possibilities to provide assistance with medical supplies. Relief goods for 3.000 people in the districts of Bacau and Vrancea will be distributed by Caritas Austria in close cooperation of with the local administration starting 20 July 05. The goods are being purchased in Iasi with the help of Caritas Romania.

4.2.2 The funds are provided via the B-FAST structure to the affected population. The financial assistance is intended to help to buy the most necessary goods (blankets, sleeping bags, hygiene kits, soap, etc) through the local Red Cross network.

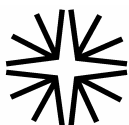
4.6 Netherlands
