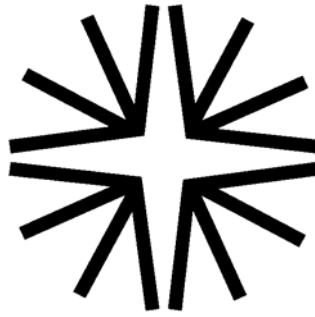

1. Situation update:

- 1.1 The declared "Disaster Situation" in the affected municipalities along the Danube River still remains.
- 1.2 The water level prognosis for 05.05.2006
 - Rouse - anticipated level - 788 cm above normal water level
 - Silistra - anticipated level - 780 cm above normal water level
- 1.3 The water level in Danube River is reduced with 5 - 10 cm daily
- 1.4 Measures for epidemic prevention are taken.

2. Bulgarian authorities have received a large number of sandbags and the request is fulfilled. The remaining request for assistance is still valid.
