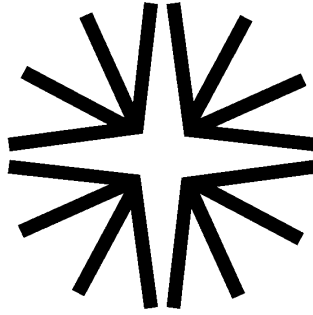

1. Situation update:

1.1. The situation in the Northern part of the country is under control.

1.2. In the Cahul region (South part of Republic) along Prut river the situation is still tensed.

1.3. Works on the strengthening of the dikes, which is still in danger are continuing in the villages: Valeni, Vadul lui Isac, Slobocia Mare and Colibash. Approximately 89 persons (rescuers, militaries and carabinieri) and 27 vehicles are involved to this works.

2. International assistance still urgently required:

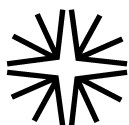

The EU MIC is heavily involved in managing the consequences in the stricken country by facilitating offers of the EU member states, which are listed above. In addition, the EU MIC has dispatched an expert team to Chisinau to facilitate the incoming European assistance, liaise with other partners and help the Government to identify further needs.
