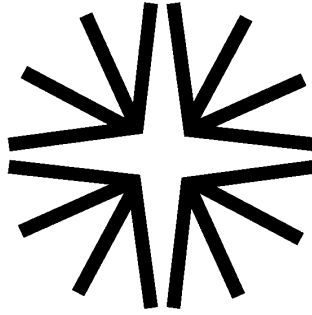

1.3.In the Northern part of the country, evacuated people are returning to their houses.

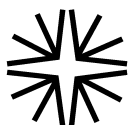
