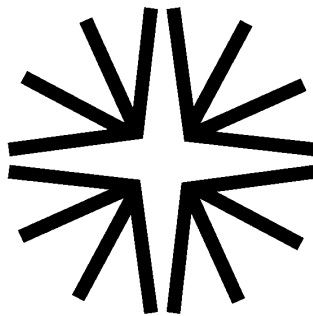

1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received today, 9th of October 2008, a disaster assistance request from **KYRGYZSTAN**. The following information was provided.

2. General Situation

Type of the Disaster : **EARTHQUAKE**
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : **5 OCTOBER 2008**
Location of the Disaster : Kyrgyzstan: Alai Region, Osh oblast

3. Initial Assessment of the damage and description of the situation.

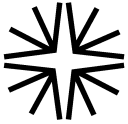
3.1. According to the Government of Kyrgyzstan the southern part of the country was hit by a 8-magnitude earthquake on 5th October 2008.

3.2. In Nura village, Alai region (houses – 211, population – 941) 75 people have died, 150 people have been evacuated to receive medical care, 128 houses have been destroyed completely, 95 percent of the infrastructure has been destroyed. Destruction is concentrated in the mountains close to the border with China.

3.3. At present time, the specialists of Ministry of Emergency Situations of the Kyrgyz Republic are working on the elimination of earthquake consequences and they are identifying the value of destruction. Rescue workers are still searching for survivors under the rubble. The remote location of the village is hampering rescue efforts.

4. National resources available for disaster response and measures taken.

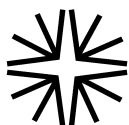
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4.1. Kyrgyzstan has involved more than 150 rescuers and more than 25 vehicles, as well as 4 helicopters in the rescue operations. Humanitarian aid such as a winter shelter-tents, heaters and food supplies are been supplied. The Government of the Kyrgyz Republic made a decision to allot from State Budget about 10 million soms.

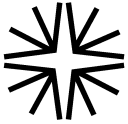
