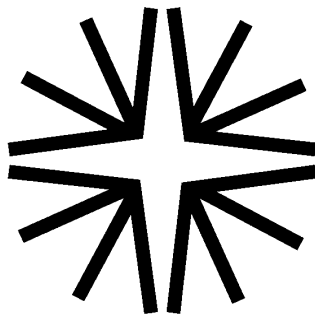

1. Situation update.

1.1. Searching works under the rubbles are completed. According to the Government of Kyrgyzstan 74 people died (41 Children) and 142 were injured (93 children) as a result of the earthquake.

1.2. The injured people were transported to Osh health facilities.

1.3. About 1000 people are homeless.

1.4. The Kyrgyz Government has set up a tented camp for 600 individuals (80 tents) at Nura village. The population of the affected villages does not consider resettlement options.

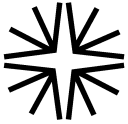
2. According to the UN-OCHA SitRep No.3 urgent humanitarian needs of the affected population have been met. The Government of Kyrgyzstan is requesting the procurement of **prefabricated houses/shelters in prevision of the winter**.

3. The following EAPC countries have assisted the stricken country on bilateral basis:

3.1. **Germany** has provided 10 tons of food supplies through its Embassy in the Kyrgyz Republic.

3.2. **Italy** has donated the amount of 70.000 euros to IFRC in response to urgent humanitarian needs of the population in Kyrgyzstan.

3.3.**Russia**: on Tuesday October 7, 2008 EMERCOM of Russia with its IL-76 flight airlifted to Kyrgyzstan 31,18 MT of relief items including 143 winterized tents, 2000 blankets and 143 heaters. All the items were delivered to the city of Osh and handed over to the local authorities for further distribution among the affected population.

3.4.**Slovakia** has pledged USD100000.

3.5.**Tajikistan** has provided non-specified assistance.

3.6.**Turkey** has provided non-specified assistance.

3.7.**Uzbekistan** has provided non-specified assistance.
