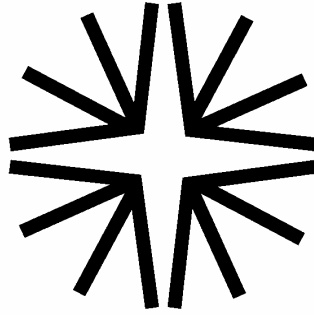

1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received today, 19 May 2010, a disaster assistance request from Tajikistan. The following information was provided.

2. General Situation

Type of the Disaster : **Multiple natural disasters**
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : **Started in January 2010**
Location of the Disaster : **Tajikistan**

3. Initial Assessment of the damage and description of the situation.

3.1. Due to the number of natural disasters in Tajikistan, including an earthquake in the Gorno-Badakhshan region on 2 January 2010 and continuous heavy rainfalls from 25 March to 12 May, multiple damages were reported to citizens and economy including flooding, mudflows and landslides in 21 districts. Twenty cities are being affected by disaster. Forty people died, 33 are missing and 300 are injured. The situation has become more crucial especially in the areas with difficult access.

4. National resources available for disaster response and measures taken.

4.1. Tajikistan is using its own limited resources which are not sufficient to deal with the consequences of this complex natural disaster.
