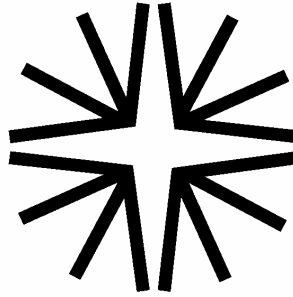

1. Situation update:

1.1 Tajikistan has faced recently several natural disasters, including heavy precipitation, triggering floods, landslides and mudflows in many of the country's districts. Disasters have started with an earthquake in the Gorno-Badakhshan region on 2 January 2010 and continuous heavy rainfalls from 25 March to 12 May.

1.2 According to the Tajik authorities nearly 20 000 people were affected, 40 persons died. Some 70,000 people were affected in their access to safe drinking water.

1.3 Rapid Emergency Assessment and Coordination Team (REACT Tajikistan) reported on 19th of May that the government responded rapidly to the emergency with search and rescue operations and evacuation of affected families. Within a week, two tent camps were erected in Kulyab town to house 4,500 people displaced by the floods. Medical care was provided to 300 injured people. Heavy machinery has been made available to help cleaning of mud, rocks and rubble in the affected areas and to repair or reinforce river banks. The government has further allocated land for resettlement of the affected families and is in the process of finalizing a master plan for the new site. The private sector and individuals made generous donations. In addition, REACT partners distributed relief items and helped install safe drinking water and sanitation facilities in the camps.

3. Assistance provided/offered by EAPC Nations:

3.1 The Government of **Kazakhstan** has decided to donate 50 million KZT (~340 000 USD).

3.2 **Spain** is preparing a shipment (around 1 ton) of medicines and medical equipment, including Rapid Response Kits, Paediatric Kits and Traumatology kits. According to the Spanish Ministry of Defence the assistance will be shipped (planned for 12th June) from the military airport near Madrid to Dushanbe airport using a Boeing-707 airplane of the Spanish Air Force.

3.3 Spain is also generously offering a transportation opportunity (free of charge) for other possible offers of assistance depending on their weight and volume on the Spanish Air Force flight to Dushanbe. The cargo should be delivered to Madrid, and should be prepared for the airlift (paper work).
