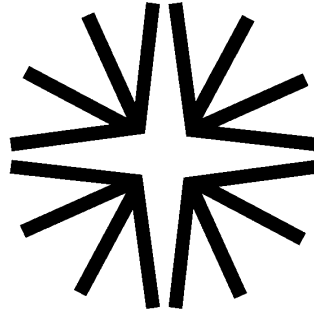

1. Situation update:

1.1 Several regions of Tajikistan suffered from floods and avalanches caused by heavy showers. Since the beginning of the disasters 42 people died, number of personnes is missing.

1.2 The disaster has damaged more than 1500 houses, dozens of bridges, thousands of kilometres of road and some 2500 hectares of plantations.

1.3 The Tajik government is responding to the emergency with search and rescue operations and evacuation of affected families. Heavy machinery has been made available to help cleaning of mud, rocks and rubble in the affected areas and to repair or reinforce river banks. The authorities have further allocated land for resettlement of the affected families and is in the process of finalizing a master plan for the new site.

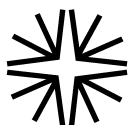

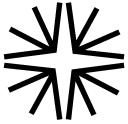

3. Assistance provided/offered by EAPC Nations:

3.1 The Government of **Italy** has decided to grant a contribution of €25.000,00 (twenty-five thousand euros) in favour of the Bilateral Emergency Fund of the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC).

3.2 The Government of **Kazakhstan** has decided to donate 50 million KZT (~340 000 USD).



3.3 The **Russian** Ministry for Emergencies has sent humanitarian aid to Tajikistan, including mobile electric power stations, large tents and foodstuffs. The total weight of the humanitarian cargo amounts to 80 tons. The assistance was delivered on 1 June.

3.4 **Spain** is preparing a shipment (around 1 ton) of medicines and medical equipment, including Rapid Response Kits, Paediatric Kits and Traumatology kits. According to the Spanish Ministry of Defence the assistance will be shipped (planned for 12th June) from the military airport near Madrid to Dushanbe airport using a Boeing-707 airplane of the Spanish Air Force. **Spain is also generously offering a transportation opportunity (free of charge) for other possible offers of assistance depending on their weight and volume on the Spanish Air Force flight to Dushanbe. The cargo should be delivered to Madrid, and should be prepared for the airlift (paper work).**

3.5 The **United States** provided \$50,000 (fifty thousand US dollars) through USAID/Tajikistan to Save the Children for the provision of humanitarian relief supplies, including hygiene kits, blankets, first aid supplies, and other non-food items, to displaced individuals living in tent communities.
