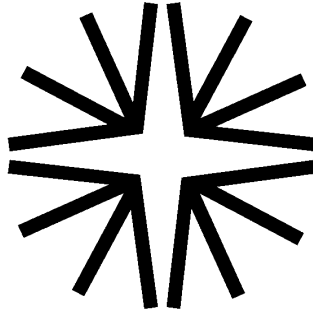

3. Assistance provided by EAPC Nations:

3.1 On 4th of June Republic of **Belarus** sent to the stricken nation the following assistance:

- Blankets – 5000 pieces;
- Canned meat – 40032 pieces;
- Canned sweet milk – 5040 pieces;
- Sugar – 5000 kg;
- Soaps – 2800 pieces.

The assistance's value is USD 164000.

3.2 The Government of **Germany** has decided to allocate the amount of 50.000 Euro (fifty thousand euros) in support of humanitarian aid in favour of the victims of the floods in Tajikistan. The support will be provided to the Tajik province of Chatlon through the German Embassy Dushanbe in cooperation with the NGO "Oxfam GB". The humanitarian aid will include the provision of household goods as well as the rehabilitation of water supply and provisional lavatories.

3.3 The Government of **Italy** has decided to grant a contribution of 25.000,00 Euro (twenty-five thousand euros) in favour of the Bilateral Emergency Fund of the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC). This contribution will fully cover the financing of the emergency operation called "Tajikistan: Floods" (DREF operation n. MDRTJ008 15 April 2010), together with the funds already granted to that end by the European Commission. Specifically the funds will be utilized by the Red Crescent Society of Tajikistan to provide to 120 families (720 beneficiaries) first aid emergency supplies such as tents, blankets, mattresses, drinkable water, hygiene kits and medical kits. Finally, in the framework of this emergency operation,



assistance will also be provided in terms of psychological support to the victims in order to facilitate a smooth return to stability, over the next four months, namely in the districts of Vose, Shurobod, Muminobod, Sarband and Istaravstan.

3.4 The Government of **Kazakhstan** has donated 50 million KZT (~340 000 USD).

3.5 The **Russian** Ministry for Emergencies delivered humanitarian aid to Tajikistan on 2nd of June, including:

- mobile generators (80kW) – 4 units;
- summer tents “Pamir-30” – 20 kits;
- summer tents “Pamir-10” – 90 kits;
- sugar – 20 tons;
- canned fish – 1094 boxes (17 tons);
- canned meat – 1492 boxes (20 tons).

The overall estimated cost of the Russian emergency humanitarian operation is about USD 661000.

3.6 **Spain** is going to send the medicines and medical equipment on 12th of June. Estimated arrival time is 05.30 Z (10.30 local time) on 13th of June to Dushanbe Airport. The gross weight of the shipment will be around 400 kg and the estimated price is 5.000 euros.

3.7 The Government of **Ukraine** delivered to Tajikistan on 9th of June assistance, including 15 diesel generators (24 KWT) and 88 large capacity tents. The total cost of humanitarian aid with air transportation is 4.860.000 UAH (~600000 USD).

3.8 The **United States** provided \$50,000 (fifty thousand US dollars) through USAID/Tajikistan to Save the Children for the provision of humanitarian relief supplies, including hygiene kits, blankets, first aid supplies, and other non-food items, to displaced individuals living in tent communities.
