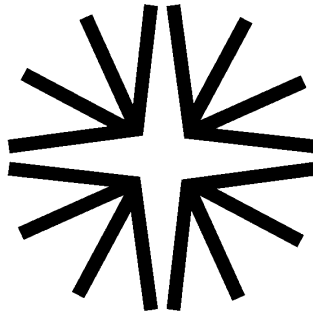

1. Situation update:

1.1 Due to continuous rainfall in Northern part of Albania during November and December, 2010, there have been multiple feeds in the water basins i.e. lake of Shkodra, Buna's river and Hydropower Plants on the Drini River.

1.2 Albanian authorities have evacuated more than 12 000 inhabitants from flooded area. Approximately 2600 buildings/houses have been flooded and 4610 surrounded by water. More than 14 000 ha farmlands have been flooded.

1.3 The transport and agricultural infrastructure have been badly affected by a disaster.

2. Action taken by the Government of Albania.

2.1 All national resources are heavily involved in dealing with consequences of the disaster.

3. Assistance provided:

3.1 **Austria** has offered 32 family tents (for up to 10 persons each), bulkheads and additional equipment. The tents (dimension: 6x 5,6 x 2,7m each) and equipment are packed on total 12 pallets. The offer has been accepted by stricken Nation and Austrian authorities are now in the process to organize appropriate transport solutions for this assets.

3.2 **Greece** has deployed two helicopters to the disaster area. Additionally one C-130 aircraft has delivered materials to Tirana airport for distribution.

3.3 **Italian** Civil Protection has provided 34 tons of food supplies, hygienic materials and rainproof suits.

3.4 On 2 December the ministry for the **Kosovo** Security Force (KSF) deployed a team (59 pax, 14 vehicles and 4 boats) to Albania to support the flood relief efforts. The KSF is liaising directly with the Albanian Authorities.

3.5 **Turkey** has offered 150 tents, 1000 blankets and has dispatched to Albania 3 helicopters.

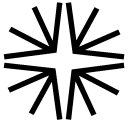
