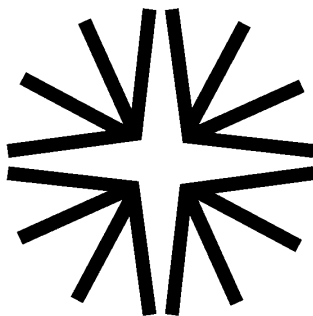

## EADRCC SITUATION REPORT N° 3 ON THE FLOOD/ALBANIA

### 1. Update on the Situation in Albania

1.1. A state of emergency still remains in effect in 7 of 12 prefectures. So far, authorities have assessed 185 houses as damaged or uninhabitable. Otherwise, weather has turned for the better unexpectedly and contrary to what had been forecasted. Therefore, the situation has somewhat stabilised for now.

### 2. National Response

2.1. At present, there are a total of 1,065 personnel committed from both Albanian Armed Forces and Civil Protection Base. Also, a total of 1,355 personnel consisting of State employees, LEMA officers, state reserves, the Adra Humanitarian Foundation and others are involved with assistance efforts. Albanian military forces have managed to close the gates of the Artificial Lake dam in Tirana

### 3. Outstanding requirements for assistance

- 3.1. Food: Rice, oil, sugar, pasta and canned meat;
- 3.2. Blankets, beds and mattresses;
- 3.3. High-pressure cleaners;
- 3.4. Fans and portable dryers; and
- 3.5. Mesh for the strengthening of hillsides exposed to rain to prevent land and rock slides.
