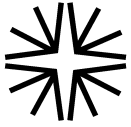

**1. General situation**

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic

1.1. This situation report highlights confirmed developments since the previous EADRCC Situation Report (OPS(EADRCC)(2020)0114)). Previously reported information is not included in this report.

1.2. To date, the EADRCC has received 21 requests for international assistance related to COVID-19, 8 of which are closed: Spain, Montenegro, Italy, Georgia, Slovenia, Bulgaria, UN OCHA (1 September) and Czech Republic (29 October 2020).



## **2. New requests for assistance through the EADRCC**

2.1. The Czech Republic requested international assistance on 22 October 2020 (OPS(EADRCC)(2020)0116). This request was fulfilled by the Pandemic Response Trust Fund project A/04 on 27 October 2020.

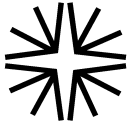
2.2. The Slovak Republic requested international assistance through the EADRCC on 28 October 2020. The requested items were further coordinated with the Slovak Republic and distributed to the EADRCC its humanitarian distribution list on 29 October 2020 with reference OPS(EADRCC)(2020)0120.
