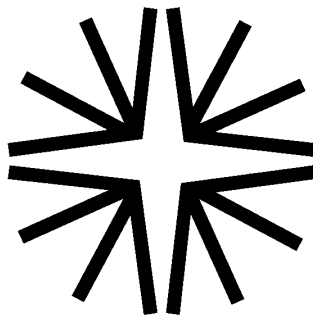

1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC ~~has received today,~~ **on** 26 March 2020, a request for international assistance. The following information was provided.

2. **General Situation**

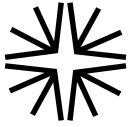
Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : 31 January 2020 and ongoing
Location of the Disaster : Italy

3. **Initial Assessment of the damage and description of the situation**

3.1. On 31 January, the Italian Government declared a state of emergency due to the first cases of COVID-19. In February, eleven municipalities in northern Italy were identified as the centres of the two main Italian clusters and placed under quarantine.

3.2. According to the data released by the Italian Department of Civil Protection on the daily bulletin of 24 of March 2020, 69.176 total COVID-19 cases have been detected, and 6.820 have died.

3.3. ***Updated assessment: on 19 April at 1800, the Ministry of Health has registered 108257 COVID-19 confirmed cases, 23660 deceased and 47055 recovered persons.***



3.4. The Department of firefighters, public rescue and civil defense of the Italian Ministry of the Interior requests international assistance in its response to the global pandemic of the coronavirus COVID-19. The Department of firefighters, public rescue and civil defense is acting in favour of the civil population to mitigate the virus spread.

3.5. In order to prevent the spread of the virus among the Italian Fire and Rescue operators, and in the civil population, we kindly ask our international partners to provide assistance to the Ministry of Interior of Italy in supplying humanitarian assistance.

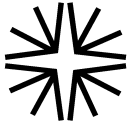
