

1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, *yesterday evening 26 March 2020, EADRCC has received an update to the Montenegrin request* for international assistance. The following information was provided.

2. General Situation

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic

Date and Time the Disaster occurred : Ongoing Location of the Disaster : Montenegro

3. Initial Assessment of the damage and description of the situation

3.1. Montenegro is facing the COVID-19 outbreak. Today, in Montenegro we have 67 confirmed cases of COVID-19. Most of them are in municipality of Tuzi. Tuzi is now in lockdown. The overall rate is 13/100 000 citizens, whereas in Tuzi it is 137/100 000 citizens. 6 500 citizens are under supervision! Every city has dedicated one to two areas for quarantine. We are expecting a rapid growth of confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the next few weeks.
