1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received today, 23 March 2020, a request for international assistance. The following information was provided.

2. General Situation

Date and Time the Disaster occurred : 9 March 2020 and ongoing
Location of the Disaster : Spain

3. Initial Assessment of the damage and description of the situation

3.1 The Armed Forces of Spain request international assistance in their response to the global pandemic of the coronavirus COVID-19. The Armed Forces of Spain are acting in favour of civil population to mitigate the virus spread.

3.2 In order to prevent the spread of the virus in the military units of the Armed Forces of Spain and in the civil population, we ask our international partners to provide assistance to the Ministry of Defence of Spain in supplying humanitarian assistance.

4.2.	Respirators, type FFP3	150 000
4.3.	Respirators, type FFP2	300 000
4.4.	Infrared radiation thermometers	1 000
4.5.	Protective face shields	5 000
4.6.	Protective eyewear	10 000
4.7.	Surgical masks	1 500 000
4.8.	Nitrile gloves	120 000
4.9.	COVID-19 rapid test	500 000
4.10.	Polymerase chain reaction diagnostic test systems	50 000
4.11.	Mechanic ventilators	500
