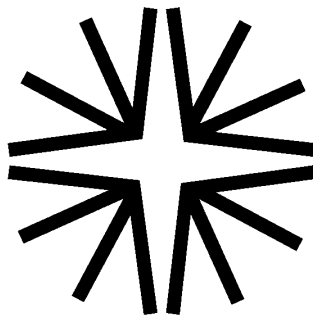

1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received **on**, Wednesday 1 April 2020, a request for international assistance. The following information was provided.

2. **General situation**

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : 7 March 2020 and ongoing
Location of the Disaster : Republic of Moldova

3. **Updated assessment of the damage and description of the situation**

3.1. The Republic of Moldova is dealing with the COVID-19 outbreak. As of **22 April, there were 2,778 confirmed cases of COVID-19. Thus far, the Republic of Moldova registered 77 deceased and 661 recovered.**

3.2. The main institution dealing with the crisis is the Ministry of Health, Labour and Social Protection. The specialized medical institutions of the Ministry of Interior and Ministry of Defence are involved as well.

3.3. The Republic of Moldova declared the state of emergency on 17 March 2020 for 60 days.
