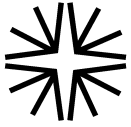
1. General situation

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : Ongoing
Location of the Disaster : NATO Allied and partner nations, and others

1.1. This situation report only highlights confirmed developments since the last EADRCC Situation Report (OPS(EADRCC)(2020)0080)). Except for the summary in paragraph 1.3, previously reported information is not included in this report.

1.2. Since the last report, Slovenia has requested assistance with the transport of necessary protective and medical equipment to Slovenia (OPS(EADRCC)(2020)0082). That request has been forwarded to Allies and to the SHAPE COVID Task Force for coordination.

1.3. So far six allied and five partner nations have requested international assistance through the Euro-Atlantic Disaster Response Coordination Centre (EADRCC). In chronological order of requesting, these are: Ukraine, Spain, Montenegro, Italy, Albania, the Republic of North Macedonia, the Republic of Moldova, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Colombia and Slovenia.



2. Completed bilateral offers of humanitarian assistance through the EADRCC

2.1. On Friday 10 April 2020, the Czech Republic delivered through a military transport aircraft, 1.000.000 masks to the Republic of North Macedonia, in response to the COVID-19 outbreak.

2.2. In response to Albania's request for medical supply support to address the COVID-19 pandemic, the United States (through US European Command) provided to Albania the following equipment: 3.000 Surgical masks, 400 N95/P2 masks, 400 Gowns, 200 pair of protective goggles, 200 protective visors, and 7.000 pairs of gloves.
