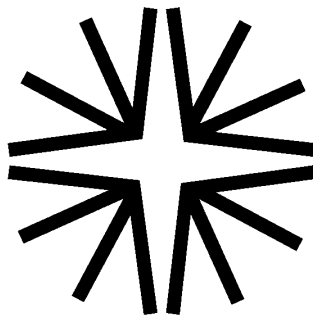

1. General situation

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : Ongoing
Location of the Disaster : NATO Allied and partner nations, and others

1.1. This situation report only highlights confirmed developments since the last EADRCC Situation Report (OPS(EADRCC)(2020)0083)). Except for the summary in paragraph 1.2, previously reported information is not included in this report.

1.2. So far, six allied and five partner nations have requested international assistance through the Euro-Atlantic Disaster Response Coordination Centre (EADRCC). In chronological order of requesting, these are: Ukraine, Spain, Montenegro, Italy, Albania, the Republic of North Macedonia, the Republic of Moldova, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Colombia and Slovenia.

2. New requests for international assistance through the EADRCC

2.1. No new requests to report.

3. Update to existing requests for international assistance

3.1. The Republic of Moldova has modified its request reflecting reductions in a series of items. A revision has been published under reference OPS(EADRCC)(2020)0071(REV5).

3.2. Allies and partners are highly encouraged to inform EADRCC when any requested support is received so that their requests for international assistance can be updated accordingly. This will help to ensure that assistance is provided in accordance with up-to-date requirements. Nations are also encouraged to prioritize their requirements where possible.

4. Completed bilateral offers of international assistance through the EADRCC

4.1. In response to Bosnia and Herzegovina's (BiH) request to the EADRCC, the United States (through US European Command) provided the following supplies to Bosnia and Herzegovina on 14 April: 13.900 protective face masks (one-time use), 5.000 protective face masks (multiple use), Disinfectant; 500 one-liter bottles and 100 five-liter bottles.

4.2. In response to the Republic of North Macedonia's request to the EADRCC, the United States (through US European Command) provided the following supplies on 15 April: 10.000 3-layer surgical masks, 2.000 Type-C protective suits, 20.000 protective shoe covers.

4.3. In response to the request submitted to the EADRCC by the Italy and Spain, for medical supply support to address the COVID-19 pandemic, Estonia will provide the following supplies to both countries: 25.000 surgical masks, 5.000 respirators type FFP2, 2.000 bottles of HandDes Liquid 500ml (containing ethanol 73,5g/100g). Coordination is ongoing for the delivery of such material.
