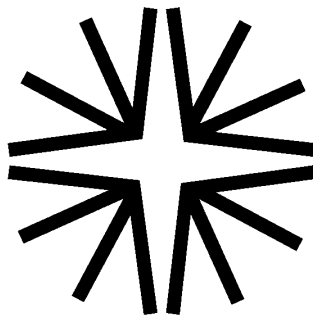

1.1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received today, Wednesday 1 April 2020, a request for international assistance. The following information was provided.

2. General situation

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : March 2020 and ongoing
Location of the Disaster : Bosnia and Herzegovina

3. Initial assessment of the damage and description of the situation

3.1. As around Europe, the novel coronavirus (COVID-2019) pandemic has also affected Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH) and infected a large number of persons. Throughout the country the restrictive measures have been introduced: cancelation of mass gatherings, sport activities, education and general promotion of social distancing, as well as the progressive measures, such as is the case with surveillance at points of entry, active detection and isolation.

3.2. The undertaken measures have somewhat slowed the spread of infection, though its further spread-out would result with even larger number of patients, as well as with increased mortality rate. All available resources have been engaged and we have undertaken extraordinary efforts to stop the spreading of COVID-19 in all the sectors and the whole of our society. The health system and other relevant sectors in Bosnia and



Herzegovina, however, do not have capacities to respond to all needs resulting from COVID-19 infection.

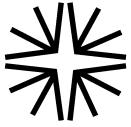
3.3. Due to limitations of our medical, civil protection and the BiH Armed Forces capacities, we are not able to deal with this issue with own resources only. Aiming to cope with novel coronavirus (COVID-2019) pandemic, the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina convened on 1 April 2020 to reach the decision for requesting international assistance for protection and rescue. ***Additionally, on 11 May, additional assistance was requested, in the form of equipment to permit the Armed Forces of Bosnia and Herzegovina to conduct aero-medical evacuation of COVID-19 patients. (See items 4.111 – 4.112 below.)***

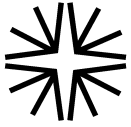

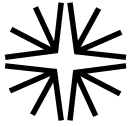

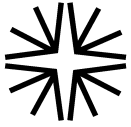
