1. General situation

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : Ongoing
Location of the Disaster : NATO Allied and partner nations, and others

1.1. This situation report only highlights confirmed developments since the last EADRCC Situation Report (OPS(EADRCC)(2020)0104)). Except for the summary in paragraphs 1.2 and 1.3, previously reported information is not included in this report.

1.2. So far, seven Allied and nine partner nations have requested international assistance through the Euro-Atlantic Disaster Response Coordination Centre (EADRCC). In chronological order of requesting, these are: Ukraine, Spain, Montenegro, Italy, Albania, the Republic of North Macedonia, the Republic of Moldova, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Colombia, Slovenia, Afghanistan, Mongolia, Bulgaria, Tunisia and Iraq. In addition, the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (UN OCHA) also requested international assistance through the EADRCC. Due to ongoing developments, the Republic of Moldova issued a second request for international assistance.

1.3. To date, thirteen requests for international assistance remain active. The requests for international assistance received from Spain on 23rd March 2020, from Italy on 26th March 2020, from Slovenia on 14th April, from Montenegro on 26th May and from Bulgaria on 5th May are now closed.

4. Update to existing requests for international assistance

4.1. Allies and partners are highly encouraged to inform EADRCC when any requested support is received so that their requests for international assistance can be updated accordingly. This will help to ensure that assistance is provided in accordance with up-to-date requirements. Nations are also encouraged to prioritize their requirements where possible. The EADRCC further encourages nations to assess whether international assistance is still required under current circumstances or whether their requests can be closed at this time.

6. Ongoing offers of bilateral assistance affecting EADRCC requests

6.1. **Poland** is providing further assistance to Iraq in the form of 1 000 litres of disinfectant. The assistance will be handed over on 2 July 2020.

6.2. **Poland** is also providing assistance to Ukraine under the Union Civil Protection Mechanism. The State Fire Service is responsible for transportation of the goods listed below:

- 40 000 Medical disposable masks ZARYS BETAtex;
- 9 600 Face shields WADIM K 2020;
- 50 220 litres liquid antiseptic Trisept Complex (hands and surfaces);
- 4 500 litres disinfection liquid VILLA SEPT;
- 1 000 sets of safety gear and shoe covers (set) ROLSON;
- 2 000 Safety Face shield SAFECOVER;

- 50 000 disposable powdered gloves VELO LATEX;
- 20 000 packages of 5 litres NITROSEPT Hand Sanitizer;
- 9 650 litres of Dr MANUSteril- Hand disinfection WHO-01;
- 7 000 pieces of protective Beaver nr 1/2020;
- 6 095 litres of liquid antiseptic Trisept Complex (surfaces and devices);
- 17 820 litres liquid surface disinfectant ORLEN;
- 19 800 litres liquid hand disinfectant ORLEN

7. Other bilateral assistance reported to the EADRCC

7.1. On 15 June **Canada** announced that in response to a global request from the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (UN OCHA), the Canadian Armed Forces will provide airlift support to transport urgently needed medical and humanitarian supplies to and from distribution hubs in Africa, Europe and the Middle East on behalf of the WFP and WHO.

7.2. **Poland** is providing assistance to Italy under the Union Civil Protection Mechanism. The State Fire Service is responsible for transportation of the goods. Please find below details of the provided civil protection assistance :

- 22 000 litres hand sanitizer;
- 30 000 surgical masks; and
- 4 800 face shields.

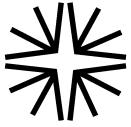
