1. General situation

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : Ongoing
Location of the Disaster : NATO Allied and partner nations, and others

1.1. This situation report only highlights confirmed developments since the previous EADRCC Situation Report (OPS(EADRCC)(2020)0110)). Except for the summary in paragraphs 1.2 through 1.4, previously reported information is not included in this report.

1.2. So far, seven Allied and nine partner nations have requested international assistance through the Euro-Atlantic Disaster Response Coordination Centre (EADRCC). In chronological order of requesting, these are: Ukraine, Spain, Montenegro, Italy, Albania, the Republic of North Macedonia, the Republic of Moldova, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Colombia, Slovenia, Afghanistan, Mongolia, Bulgaria, Tunisia and Iraq. In addition, the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (UN OCHA) also requested international assistance through the EADRCC.

1.3. Due to ongoing developments in the region, the Commander of the Kosovo Force (COM KFOR) requested international assistance through the EADRCC. The request was distributed to our points of contact on 31 August 2020.

1.4. To date, thirteen requests for international assistance remain active. The requests for international assistance received from Spain on 23rd March 2020, from Italy on 26th March 2020, from Slovenia on 14th April, from Bulgaria on 5 May 2020, from Montenegro on 26 March 2020 and from Georgia on 3 April 2020 are now closed.
