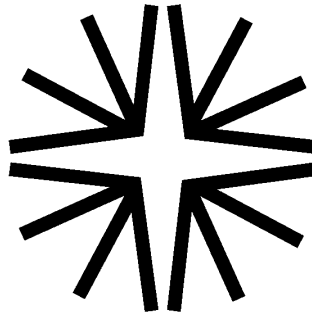

1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received today, Wednesday 17 February 2021, a request for international assistance. The following information was provided.

2. General situation

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : Beginning of February 2020 and ongoing
Location of the Disaster : Georgia, countrywide

3. Assessment of the damage and description of the situation

3.1. In Georgia, all the available resources are engaged to stop the spread of COVID-19. The National Center for Disease Control and Public Health of Georgia reported 266,948 confirmed coronavirus cases, 3,390 of which died. 259,727 patients recovered from the disease.

3.2. The Georgian Government developed a national vaccination plan: 60% of the adult population needs to be vaccinated in 2021, requiring 3,979,327 doses of the vaccine.

4. The following request for international assistance has been identified with very high priority:

4.1. COVID-19 vaccines (Pfizer or Moderna) 50,000 doses
