1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received an updated request for international assistance from Ukraine. The following information was provided.

2. **General Situation**

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : 3 March 2020 and ongoing
Location of the Disaster : Ukraine

3. **Initial Assessment of the damage and description of the situation:**

3.1 The Ministry of Health of Ukraine has identified 15 400 confirmed COVID-19 cases in Ukraine, with 481 dead and 11 400 recovered per day (April 2021). Quarantine, **lockdown** and restrictive measures are in place. The Ministry of Health, Ministry of Defence, Ministry of Interior, State Emergency Service, State Border Guard Service, National Police, National Guard, and Security Service of Ukraine request international assistance in their response to the global pandemic of the coronavirus COVID-19.

3.2 In order to fulfill their normal tasks under pandemic conditions, as well as additional tasks related to countering and preventing the spread of COVID-19 across the country, we ask our international partners to provide assistance to the security and defence sector bodies of Ukraine in supplying humanitarian assistance.

3.3 In the light of the emergency that Ukraine is experiencing against COVID-19 the Government of Ukraine has decided to update their request for international assistance.

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Therefore, the Ministry of Health and **State Emergency Service of Ukraine** request international assistance in its response to the global pandemic in Ukraine.

3.4 Taking into account the increasing number of cases caused by COVID-19 and the emergency viral situation in Ukraine, **the Ministry of Health of Ukraine is also requesting international assistance in finding suppliers of a vaccine against COVID-19.**

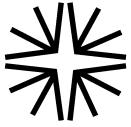

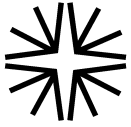
