1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received on Wednesday 21 April 2021, a request for international assistance by the Republic of Moldova. The following information was provided.

2. General situation

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : 7 March 2020 and ongoing
Location of the Disaster : Republic of Moldova

3. Assessment of the damage and description of the situation

- 3.1. The Ministry of Health, Labour and Social Protection, Republic of Moldova request international assistance in their response to the COVID-19 global pandemic.
- 3.2. In order to prevent the spread of the virus in the Republic of Moldova, we ask our international partners to provide assistance to the Ministry of Health, Labour and Social Protection, Republic of Moldova in supplying humanitarian assistance.
- 3.3. The Republic of Moldova is dealing with the COVID-19 outbreak. As of April 21 2021, there were 246,691 confirmed cases of COVID-19. Thus far, the Republic of Moldova registered 5,616 deceased and 233,281 recovered.
- 3.4. The main institution dealing with the crisis is the Ministry of Health, Labour and Social Protection. The specialized medical institutions of the Ministry of Interior and Ministry of Defence are involved as well.
- 3.5. The Republic of Moldova declared the state of emergency on 31 March 2021 for 60 days.
