### 1. **Description**

1.1. On 06 February 2023 at 01:17 GMT, a powerful 7.8-magniture earthquake struck southern Türkiye 26 km east of Şekeroba.

1.2. As a result, at least 284 people have died according to local Turkish officials. Several buildings have collapsed and many people are trapped.

1.3. The earthquake affected 10 cities including Gaziantep, Kahramanmaras, Hatay, Osmaniye, Adiyaman, Malatya, Sanliurfa, Adana, Diyarbakir and Kilis.

2. The following requested items for emergency aid have been identified by Türkiye:
