1. On 06 February 2023, in accordance with the procedures at reference, the EADRCC has received an updated request for additional items from Türkiye.

2. **Description**

- 2.1. On 06 February 2023 at 01:17 UTC, a powerful **7.7** magnitude earthquake struck southern Türkiye near Gaziantep. At 10:04 UTC, a second powerful earthquake of 7.5 magnitude struck the Kahramanmaraş area. Weather conditions are extreme. Aftershocks continue throughout the affected area.
- 2.2. As a result, at least **3,381** people have died according to local Turkish officials. **5,700** buildings have collapsed and many people are trapped. At least **20,426** people have been injured.
