Anne Trebilcock is former Vice-President of the Asian Development Bank Administrative Tribunal and of the GAVI Alliance Appeals Tribunal. She has served as a neutral in dispute resolution in other international organizations, including the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development and the International Federation of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies. She is former Legal Adviser/Director of Legal Services at the International Labour Organization in Geneva, where she worked in various capacities in a legal career that spanned two and half decades. Earlier, she practiced law in the United States.

She has lectured at several universities in Europe and North America. She is author of various journal articles and book chapters, particularly on aspects of public international law, the law of international organizations, and international labour law. She is the editor of the *Research Collection on Comparative Labour Law* (2018) and is co-editor of the *Research Handbook on Transnational Labour Law* (2015) and of *Droit international social* (2013). She is a member of the Michigan State Bar.
