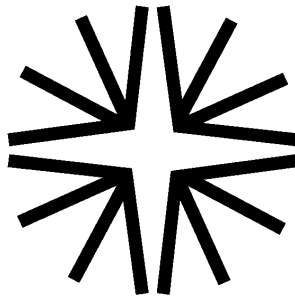


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EADRCC REQUEST FOR INTERNATIONAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE FLOODS IN SLOVENIA

1. Description

1.1. Severe weather conditions persist in Slovenia with rivers still overflowing across the country.

1.2. The Sava River is flooding heavily. The Drava River is stable in its upper reaches and is moderating in its lower reaches. The Mura River stabilized in Gornja Radgona, but reports indicate embankments were breached near the settlements of Krapje Verzej. The situation is closely monitored. The Krka River is overflowing in exposed areas and its water level continues to rise.

1.3. Currently, the most problematic areas concern the Sava and Krka Rivers, the confluence around Krška Vas, and the Mura River around the settlements of Krapje Verzej.

1.4. The water level of the Drave River is slowly receding and under control; its flow is stable and regulated, including on the Austrian side. A similar pattern is observed for the Mura River.

1.5. 1,400 civil protection and other personnel from the Slovenian Armed Forces and the Police are engaged.

1.6. Two casualties are directly connected to the floods.

1.7. Today's forecast is to be mostly cloudy, with occasional rain showers. The rain is expected to stop tonight.

1.8. Slovenia activated the Copernicus emergency satellite mapping in rapid mapping mode (EMSR680).

2. The following requested items for emergency aid have been identified by Slovenia:

No.	Description	Quantity
2.1	Helicopter with carrying weight of – at least – 5 tonnes	5
2.2	Personnel (including soldiers)	200
2.3	Modular pre-fabricated bridges with a span of 20m to 40m	20

4. **Points of entry:**

4.1. By air: Ljubljana International Airport (LJI) Joze Pucnik.

4.2. By land: will be coordinated with the offering nation.
