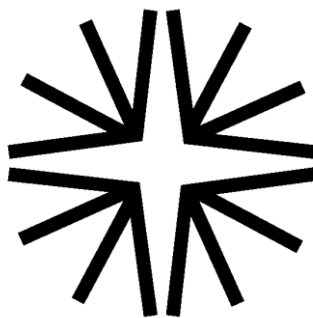

1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received on 4 December 2017, a request for assistance from Albania.

Today on March 9, 2018 the Albanian delegation to NATO has informed the EADRCC that this request for assistance is closed.

The Government of the Republic of Albania is grateful for all the assistance received and offered by the international community.

2. **Assistance offered or provided by NATO allied and partner countries:**

- Lithuania provided financial assistance of €10,000
- Kuwait provided:
 - 50 ton food

- 20 ton flour
- 120 stoves
- 2000 blankets
- 70 fridges
- 900 kg detergent

- Israel provided financial assistance of \$10,000

- Serbia provided financial assistance of €100,000 and the following in-kind assistance:
 - 500 blankets
 - 500 cover blankets
 - 250 sleeping bags
 - 250 mattress

- Italy provided:
 - 6 engineers have arrived in Albania

- Greece provided:
 - 2 trucks with 1500 rain coats
 - 100 water boots
 - 5 power generators 2.5 KVA

- Turkey provided:
 - 2007 pair of boots
 - 26 Jackets
 - 319 shirts
 - 245 cardigans
 - 7628 coats
 - 852 pullovers
 - 2499 trousers
 - 653 sweatshirts
 - 5 tights



- 29 T-shirts
- 778 long sleeve t-shirts
- 45 vests
- 1 tuning (long woman dress)

- Canadian Embassy provided:
 - 150 single mattresses with 300 \$ each

- Bosnia and Herzegovina provided:
 - 25 tons of wheat grain
 - 25 tons of corn

- France provided through the EU Civil Protection mechanism, 2 tons of relief items consisting of:
 - Motor pumps
 - Blankets
 - Water boots
 - Lamps

- Austria provided the following assistance through the EU Civil Protection mechanism:
 - 3 mobile power generators
 - 500 blankets
 - 50 life vests
 - 1 portable petrol engine driven water/mud pump incl. couplings and 2 hoses
 - 500 winter sleeping bags for adults
 - 200 units of surface disinfectant “Terralin”

- Slovakia provided the following in-kind assistance:
 - 500 sleeping bags
 - 4 water pumps plus hoses
 - 8 power generators
 - 500 rain coats
 - 80 water boots
 - 100 rubber boots



- 24 heaters
- Slovenia provided an expert and the following in-kind assistance (EU Civil Protection mechanism) :
 - 5 water pumps (low capacity)
 - 500 blankets
 - 100 rubber boots
 - 500 rain coats
 - 288 clean-up kits (100 ml)
- Montenegro provided assistance to Albania on bilateral basis on 3rd December, consisting of:
 - 1 800 blankets
 - 40 tents
 - 500 sleeping bags
 - 5 000 pads
 - 100 canisters
 - 200 jackets (raincoats)
 - 100 pairs of boots
 - 2 pumps with equipment (capacity: 800 lit/min).
- Bulgaria provided:
 - 1 500 blankets
 - 500 bed linen
 - 200 inflatable mattresses
 - 12 pumps for mattress
 - 20 tents (8 person capacity)
 - 500 raincoats
 - 900 kg. of cheese
 - 23 000 pcs of canned food (4 pallets).

3. Assistance provided by international organizations/bodies

- UNICEF provided:
 - Clothes
 - Medical kits



- UNHCR provided:
 - 1099 fleece blankets
 - 1260 synthetic sleeping mats
 - 43 family tends
 - 313 plastic tarpaulins

- Save the Children distributed:
 - 650 packages of food

- Red Cross distributed:
 - 440 packages of foods
 - 290 cleaning kits
