

1.1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received today, 28 November 2019, a request for international assistance. The following information was provided.

2. General Situation

Type of the Disaster : Earthquake

Date and Time the Disaster occurred : 26 November 2019, 03:54 Local (UTC+1)

Location of the Disaster : Durrës County, Tirana (central coastal Albania)

3. Initial Assessment of the damage and description of the situation

- 3.1. The earthquake that occurred in Albania on 26 November at 2:54 UTC (3:54 local time), 34km (21 miles) North-West of Tirana has caused loss of lives (more than 30 and the number is expected to increase), a large number of wounded (more than 700). People remain trapped under collapsed structures and there is significant damage to infrastructure including residential areas and other facilities.
- 3.2. More than 900 families have been evacuated from the affected areas and are currently sheltered in hotels, stadiums and other public facilities.
- 3.3. Food and other resources are already scarce and the Government of Albania has declared a state of emergency for two Districts Tirana and Durrës.

- 3.4. Albanian rescue teams and bilateral contributors, including Urban Search and Rescue Teams from Allies and Partner countries continue to conduct Search and Rescue Operations.
- 3.5. All national resources are heavily involved in dealing with the consequences of the disaster. All state institutions and operational forces such as: military, police and firefighting and national civil emergency personnel have been deployed at full capacity in the affected areas.
