II. CO-ORDINATION OF LIVE OAK AND NATO PLANNING

2. The CHAIRMAN suggested that instead of the discussion planned for Tuesday, 17th April, delegations who desired clarifications in connection with the United States and Italian statements of 17th April should forward any questions through the International Staff to the three powers. These questions, and the comments by the three powers, might be discussed at the time of the Council examination of the NATO Commanders' plans, which were shortly to be submitted to the Council for approval by governments through the Permanent Representatives. The discussion might take place soon after the Athens meeting.

3. This suggestion was approved.
