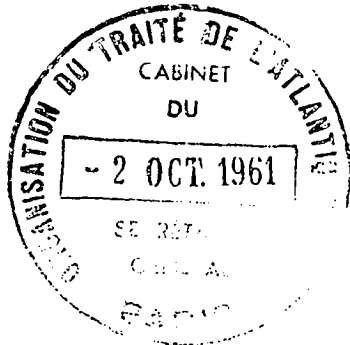
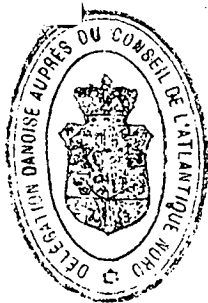

SACLANT and CINCHAN Plans of Action in Face of the
Berlin Crisis.

Danish Reply.

Re: doc. PO/61/722, Annex I, para. 3.

In case of an emergency the plan is to employ in naval units, earmarked to SACEUR, the personnel of the Danish DE mentioned.

Re: doc. PO/61/730, Annex A, para. 2.

The Danish military authorities will to the extent possible endeavour to expedite construction of the projects in Denmark mentioned in document PO/61/730 in accordance with the wishes expressed by SACLANT.

A B-estimate for the STRIKEFLEET communications project in slice 9 can be expected towards the end of 1961. The radio equipment to be installed in the station is, however, a long-lead item, but exemption from international competitive bidding for this equipment would expedite the completion by some months.

With respect to the 12. slice project in the Faroe Islands a B-estimate is, likewise, under preparation following the recent approval by the Danish financial authorities of the obligations under slice 12. This station will probably not be ready for use until the

beginning of 1963.

The preparatory measures proposed by CINCHAN concerning merchant ships are already part of the alert plans of the Danish Naval Board of Shipping.

Danish merchant ships abroad will normally be able to leave port at short notice.
